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Construction Manager

The Construction Manager is responsible for planning, directing, and overseeing all phases of construction projects to ensure work is completed safely, on schedule, within budget, and in accordance with project specifications and quality standards. This role provides leadership to construction teams, contractors, and subcontractors while coordinating closely with engineering, project management, procurement, commissioning, and client representatives to ensure successful project execution.

Responsibilities

- Plan, organize, and manage all construction activities from project mobilization through completion.
- Lead and supervise construction personnel, contractors, and subcontractors to ensure safe and efficient project execution.
- Coordinate construction schedules, workforce planning, equipment, and material requirements.
- Monitor project progress and proactively address schedule, quality, safety, and budget concerns.
- Collaborate with engineering, project management, procurement, and commissioning teams to ensure construction activities align with project objectives.
- Review construction drawings, specifications, contracts, and work packages to ensure compliance with project requirements.
- Conduct site inspections, safety meetings, and quality assurance reviews to maintain company and regulatory standards.
- Manage field changes, requests for information (RFIs), punch lists, and construction documentation.
- Prepare and present project status reports, progress updates, and performance metrics to management and clients.
- Promote a culture of safety, accountability, teamwork, and continuous improvement throughout all construction activities.

Qualifications

- Bachelor's degree in Construction Management, Engineering, or a related field preferred; equivalent industry experience may be considered.
- 10+ years of construction management experience in industrial, petrochemical, oil & gas, power generation, manufacturing, or heavy industrial environments.
- Strong knowledge of construction methods, project scheduling, quality control, and safety regulations.
- Experience managing multidisciplinary construction projects and coordinating multiple contractors.
- Strong leadership, decision-making, organizational, and conflict resolution skills.
